myAlRVO™ users are able to configure flow settings to achieve optimal comfort during the day or night. If required, supplemental medical oxygen can be easily added. A range of interfaces is available for nasal, tracheostomy and mask delivery. The interfaces do not require a seal, making them comfortable and easy to use.

The myAIRVO™ unit is suitable for customers who require humidification. Some patient groups that may benefit from this therapy are:

- Bronchietasis
